Wir erlauben uns Sie auf den **Postgraduate Course „Central Eastern Europe (CEE) Waste Manager“** hinzuweisen (siehe Anhang).

Der Kurs wird von der TU Wien in Kooperation mit der Universität Novi Sad veranstaltet und findet in zwei Teilen (**12. bis 23. Juni 2017 in Wien**, Österreich und **11. bis 22. Für den Kursteil in Novi Sad besteht für KursteilnehmerInnen mit Wohnsitz in Österreich außerdem die **Möglichkeit der Förderung der Reise- und Nächtigungskosten** in der Höhe von bis zu **€880,-**. Die Zuerkennung der Förderung sowie die Bestätigung der Anmeldung erfolgt bis **31. März 2017**.

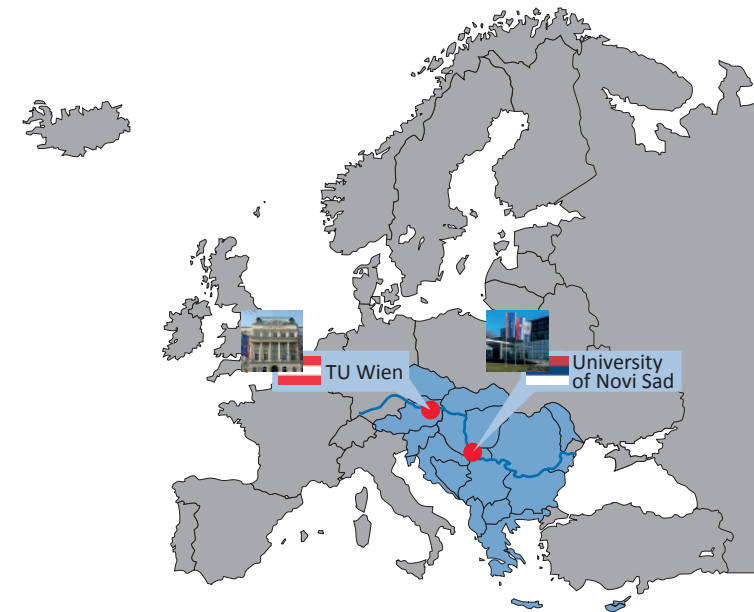

Postgraduate Course CEE Waste Manager

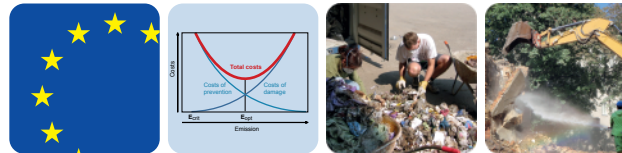
Current practice of waste management in Central Eastern Europe (CEE) is not only highly diverse in the different countries but also in ongoing transition. Whereas in affluent EU countries like Austria and Germany ever more ambitious recycling targets due to the circular economy package are arising at the horizon, in the candidate countries like Serbia or Montenegro first sanitary landfills are currently implemented. For waste management companies working in CEE these different development stages represent on the one hand a great opportunity, but on the other hand also a huge challenge. Managers and engineers working in the field need to be aware about conventional disposal solutions and newly developed recovery processes at the same time. In addition, driving forces for current and future waste solutions, in particular European waste and resources laws, must be known and recognized.

The 4 weeks postgraduate course “CEE Waste Manager” addresses practitioners and post graduate students who want to acquire a high level and practically applicable education in waste management that goes beyond conventional curricula. In cooperation between the University of Novi Sad and TU Wien altogether 8 modules (each a 10 hours) addressing different aspects of sustainable and appropriate waste management in CEE are offered.

In particular, the program includes the following modules:

At TU Wien

1. Policy and Legislation of EU Waste and Resource Management
2. Modern Evaluation Methods in Waste and Resource Management (including Life Cycle Assessment and Cost Benefit Analysis)
3. Sampling and Characterization of Waste according to European Standards
4. Management of Construction and Demolition Waste (incl. Selective Dismantling & Prospection of Hazardous Substances)



At the University of Novi Sad

5. Landfill Technology and Operation (incl. Cost Effective Monitoring and Treatment of Emissions)
6. Thermal Waste Utilization in Transition Economies (Refuse Derived Fuel Production & Utilization)
7. Biowaste Management in Central Eastern Europe
8. Material Flow Analysis as a Decision Support Tool in Waste and Resource Management.



Schedule

- Module 1 to 4 will be held at TU Wien from **June 12 till 23, 2017.**
- The modules 5 to 8 are taught at the University of Novi Sad from **September 11 to 22, 2017.**

The program is opened for **waste managers** (practitioners) and **students** (holding a Bachelor degree) from CEE countries. It is recommended to participate in all modules, whereby at minimum 4 modules are to be taken. Besides theoretical information the program includes field visits of waste facilities in Austria and Serbia and different practical exercises (e.g., sampling and analysis of refuse derived fuels, exploration of hazardous substances in buildings prior demolition).

Applications (incl. Curriculum Vitae and letter of motivation) should be sent by e-mail **not later than March 15, 2017** to either Jakob.Lederer@tuwien.ac.at or nemanjastanisavljevic@uns.ac.rs.

The program is **funded by OeAD**, the Austrian agency for international mobility and cooperation in education, science and research. Thus, **scholarship funds for traveling and accommodation** for either two weeks of participation in Austria or Serbia can be applied for.
